However, I can tell you about the Fine Art Photography course I have been taking with Martin Osner.

Martin describes himself as an artist trapped in a photographer's body. He is certainly both an accomplished artist and photographer with a long list of accolades on his Artist's Biography. He is an amazing teacher and I enjoyed the first course so much that I signed up for the second one, as did the rest of the class.

It is worth checking out

his work. Better still, visit his gallery in Hout Bay, because his work looks even better when viewed for real. There are also works by plenty of other great photographers there.

Martin taught us about shape, colour and composition but also how to create montages and use of mixed media. Photography was always part of the process but ink, paint, sand, salt, chalk—almost anything, could be added to produce interesting results like the wonderful picture at the start of this article. Candy Girl #1 is a 'traditional hand painted black and white photograph juxtaposed by the clarity of real rubber bands as hair".

As an optometrist, I spent 42 years trying to give people the sharpest vision that I could. As an amateur photographer, I tried producing tack sharp images and showing the world realistically (apart from some minor editing). Now all of that is out of the window when I practice fine art photography. If done well, we can enjoy images which have been blurred, distorted, covered with 'grunge' and taken far from reality.

Below is a selection from my course work. I hope you enjoy them. I have held two back for our August project.



























"All of my artwork is created using my own photography.


